

### A Brief History on Delroy Park

The first stage was developed in 1997 and became Delroy Park South. The Estate was developed with affordable living, lifestyle, and convenience in mind. The various available land sizes created a welcome return to a community feel in a sought-after neighbourhood.

During its development, Delroy Park retained the majority of the original vegetation whilst creating public access to open spaces, cycleways, pergolas, and play areas for adults and children. Lakes, reserves and landscaped gardens were integrated amongst the natural habitats and waterways. It is for this very reason Delroy Park was proudly awarded the GREEN RHINO environmental award from the Dubbo Chamber of Commerce and Industry. Due to the success of the first release over 20 years ago, the development of Delroy Park has continued to go from strength to strength. As new development releases became available, many community amenities were built, including a shopping centre equipped with a supermarket, doctors and general shops.

Further stages saw the development of the popular Macquarie Anglican School, followed by the Delroy Park shopping centre and further expansion of the open space pathways and community facilities. By this stage, Delroy Park was fast becoming the location of choice for many families and investors.

Well into the 14th land release, Delroy Park looks a little different than it did 20 years ago, but the original vision still forms the basis of everything Delroy Park.







### About Dubbo

Established in 1849 the Dubbo region is located approximately 400km northwest of Sydney, in the heart of the beautiful Macquarie Valley, a vibrant regional city by the majestic Macquarie River. Affectionately known as the city of smiles, Dubbo has grown significantly in the last decade. Dubbo boasts the old-fashioned charm of a country town with the advantages of a thriving metropolis.

Dubbo is one of the larger Australian country towns, it is the commercial, industrial, and administrative hub of the Central West. Dubbo is also one of Australia's fastestgrowing inland cities.

Scattered throughout Dubbo's city centre are tasty cafes and restaurants equal to those found in larger metropolitan city centres.

Dubbo's main attractions are all within minutes of the city's centre, the historic Old City Gaol and the Western Plains Cultural Centre. However, without a doubt, the main attraction is the Taronga Western Plains Zoo, home to hundreds of rare and endangered animals, including rhinos and big cats attracting approximately 134,000 tourists annually.

The area has something for everyone, from its cultural heritage, magical sunsets, entertainment, thriving business centre, and parks and playgrounds, all on the doorstep of the Australian outback.

#### Growth & Expansion

The city has enjoyed steady population growth for the past four decades. While many other agricultural centres in the region have been confronted with decline and fragile economies, Dubbo has expanded its population by 59% over 25 years.

As an emerging region with a projected population of 60,000 by 2036, there is an overwhelming need for wellplanned development and infrastructure to support the forecast growth of the town.

Dubbo is part of Australia's first Renewable Energy zone aiming to replace coal-fired power stations with solar, wind, and eco-storage facilities, making the city a national leader in environmental expansion.

#### Health & Wellness

General Practitioners and other Health Services at your fingertips include Dentists, Orthodontists, Physiotherapists, and rehabilitation facilities.

The Dubbo Region Health and Medical Services include a major Public & Private Hospital that will undergo an exciting major upgrade in 2023.

Redevelopment of the hospitals in Dubbo is to the tune of \$150 million. This will contribute to the growth of many industries during construction and ongoing employment opportunities.

The 'Alternative Health Space' is another growing sector with Naturopaths, Nutritionists, Massage Therapists, Reiki, and Mediation Masters - all available at your doorstep.

### Amenities




