

## A Brief History on Delroy Park

The very first stage was developed in 1997 and was to become Delroy Park South. The estate was developed with affordable living, lifestyle and convenience in mind, with a variety of land sizes being available which created a welcome return to a community feel and sort after neighbourhood.

During its development Delroy Park was able to retain the majority of the original vegetation whilst creating public access open spaces, cycleways, pergolas and play areas for adults and children. Lakes, reserves and landscaped gardens were also integrated amongst natural habitats and waterways and for this very reason Delroy Park was proudly awarded the GREEN RHINO environmental award from the Dubbo Chamber of Commerse and Industry.

Due to the success of the first release over 20 years ago, the development of Delroy Park has continued to go from strength to strength, as new development releases became available, many community amenities were built including a shopping centre equipped with supermarket, doctors and general shops.

Further stages saw the development of the popular Macquarie Anglican School, followed by the Delroy Park shopping centre & further expansion of the open space pathways and community facilities. By this stage, Delroy Park was fast becoming the location of choice for many families and investors.

Now well into the 14th land release, Delroy Park looks a little different than it did 20 years ago, but the original vision still forms the basis of everything Delroy Park.









### About Dubbo

Established in 1849, the Dubbo region is located approximately 400km north west of Sydney in the heart of the beautiful Macquarie Valley, a vibrant regional city by the majestic Macquarie River. Affectionately known as "the city of smiles," the city has grown significantly in the last decade. Dubbo boasts the old-fashioned charm of a country town with the advantages of a thriving metropolis.

Dubbo is one of the larger Australian country towns. It is the commercial, industrial and administrative hub of the Central West and is also one of Australia's fastestgrowing inland cities.

Scattered throughout Dubbo's city centre are tasty cafes and restaurants equal to those found in larger metropolitan city centres.

Dubbo's main attractions are all within minutes of the cities centre, the historic Old City Gaol and the Western Plains Cultural Centre, however without a doubt, the main attraction is the Taronga Western Plains Zoo, home to hundreds of rare and endangered animals including rhinos and big cats which attracts approximately 134,000 tourists annually.

The area has something for everyone, from its cultural heritage, magical sunsets, entertainment, thriving business centre and parks and playgrounds, all on the doorstep of the Australian outback.

#### Growth & Expansion

The city has enjoyed steady population growth rates for the past four decades, expanding its population by 59% over 25 years while many other agricultural centres in the region have been confronted by decline or fragile economies.

As an emerging region with a projected population of 60,000 by 2036, there is an overwhelming need for well-planned development and infrastructure to support the forecast growth of the town.

Dubbo is part of Australia's first Renewable Energy zone which aims to replace coal fired power stations with solar, wind and eco storage facilities, making the city a national leader in environmental expansion.

#### Health & Wellness


General Practitioners and other Health Services at your fingertips include Dentists, Orthodontists, Physiotherapists and rehabilitation facilities.
